As we reflect on the 2024–2025 fiscal year, our hearts are filled with profound gratitude for the incredible support from our Northeast Florida community. Over the past twelve months, your generosity, kindness, and steadfast commitment have empowered our Northeast Florida Jewish Federation & Foundation to meet extraordinary challenges with strength and unity.

This year, our 2024–2025 Annual Campaign achieved a remarkable milestone—its third consecutive year of growth, raising just shy of **\$2.8 million** through **746 gifts**, surpassing last year's total by over **\$230,000**. Simultaneously, our Foundation experienced healthy growth in assets under management, a testament to the enduring trust and commitment of our donors.

Since the horrific attack on Israel on October 7, 2023, we have witnessed a disturbing global surge in antisemitism, anti-Israel rhetoric, and Jew-hatred. But in these dark moments, our community did what it has always done in times of crisis: we came together with resilience, resolve, and compassion.

As Jewish communal leaders and professionals in the United States, we have been called to action in three vital ways:

ADVOCATE: Speak out for continued U.S. support of Israel and advocate for enhanced communal security at every level of government.

STAY CONNECTED: Deepen our relationships with Israel and our partners in the Hadera-Eiron Region.

SUSTAIN SUPPORT: Continue giving. As President Isaac Herzog has emphasized, the Jewish Federations' Emergency Campaign has been a lifeline—sustained financial contributions are essential to Israel's recovery and future.

2024-2025 HIGHLIGHTS

Locally, we remain steadfast in strengthening our community and building resilience.

- Our **Community Security Initiative** remains fully funded with multi-year commitments totaling **\$1.2 million**.
- We are honored to have been awarded a **\$350,000 state appropriation** to enhance Jewish communal safety, helping to fund off-duty law enforcement for synagogues, schools, and community events, and to sustain our vital partnership with the **Secure Community Network (SCN)**.
- In a historic step, the **St. Augustine City Commission** unanimously adopted the **International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Working Definition of Antisemitism**, becoming the first municipality in Northeast Florida to do so. This achievement reflects the powerful advocacy of our Jewish Community Relations Council (JCRC).
- This year also marked the completion of our first **Demographic Study** in over 20 years, a collaborative effort among our synagogues, agencies, and Jewish organizations that will guide our community's future.

Our community came together for meaningful conversations and actions, including:

- Screenings of the **October 8 documentary**, both publicly at Beth El-The Beaches Synagogue and privately for interfaith and community leaders,
- The launch of the **JewBelong** billboard campaign on I-95 to boldly combat Jew-hate and spark public discourse, and
- Participation in the **Jewish Federations of North America's United for Security Emergency Fly-In**, where **400 leaders from 85 Federations** and **40 national organizations** convened to advocate for national security, democratic values, and community resilience.
- City of Jacksonville mayor **Donna Deegan** hosted the **Annual American Heritage Month**, now officially proclaimed each May. **Eighty community leaders** attended our celebration of Jewish pride, excellence and values at this important commemoration.
- Together with the **Secure Community Network**, we continue to provide **free safety and emergency training**, including situational awareness, active threat response, and lay rescuer medical response.

In the following pages of this 2024-2025 Annual Report, you'll find highlights from our departments and our Honor Roll—a tribute to every donor and volunteer who strengthens Jewish life in Northeast Florida, in Israel, and around the world.

On behalf of our entire community, thank you. Your support gives us hope and inspires us every day.

We pray for the safe return of the hostages, the protection of Israel's soldiers, and the security of the Jewish people everywhere.

May we go from strength to strength.

Community Security Initiative (CSI)

New training was piloted in our community, such as **The Power of Hello** and **Be The Help Until Help Arrives**.

Continued outstanding relationship with law enforcement partners by being sworn in as a **Special Deputy Sheriff** by St. Johns County Sheriff Rob Hardwick.

AsOne CommUNITY Israel Trip

In February, our Federation joined with Richmond's to travel to Israel on a successful trip — **AsOne CommUNITY**.

We celebrated the country, mourned our many losses, and visited our Israeli family in the Partnership Region.



In its **3rd year**, the I&O Committee led major events including the award-winning **City of Jacksonville World of Nations** Israel tent.



Community-wide celebrations and recognition of **Yom HaZikaron** and **Yom Ha'atzmaut** brought more than **800 people** together.



For the first time, I&O welcomed **2 IDF soldiers** for a week who met with groups—from young children up to our **River Garden** seniors—to share about themselves, their work in the IDF, and protecting Israel.



Ziv Avtalion and Rinat Asaf-Grinberg from our **Partnership Region Hadera-Eiron** spoke throughout the community about Israel post-October 7th and their work rebuilding and strengthening the region and the State.
